AN ACT to amend the Constitution of the Republic of The Gambia, under Section 226(2), and for connected matters.

[27th July, 2017]

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Constitution of the Republic of The Gambia, 1997 (Amendment) Act, 2017.

2. Amendment of the Constitution

The Constitution of the Republic of The Gambia, 1997 (in this Act referred to as “the Constitution”) is amended as set out in this Act.

3. Amendment of section 62

Section 62 (1) (b) of the Constitution is amended by deleting the words “but not more than sixty-five years”.

4. Amendment of section 141

Section 141 (2) (b) of the Constitution is amended by substituting for the words “Seventy years”, the words “seventy-five years”.
